Here is some information about what will be happening over the next few months. The timings may change but we will keep you informed of what we are doing.

What's happening?	Estimated Date
James Trotter, Housing Manager, will visit you in your home to discuss your personal circumstances.	Appointments available from Monday 27 th February to Friday 10 th March 2017
You will need to register on Homeseeker Plus. You can do this yourself or if you need help, James will help you to do this.	During February 2017
Bromford will carry out a number of surveys of the Paterson Road area so that we can start designing the new housing layout. These will include drain surveys and topographical surveys which map the contours of the ground and existing features such as trees, manholes, utility poles, retaining walls, etc.	February 2017 onwards
You will receive a letter and a Notice formally advising you that we will be demolishing the houses and flats in the future. This is nothing to worry about. Legally we have to issue these notices to suspend any Right to Buy applications (so you don't incur any costs on applying to buy your home whilst we complete our consultations).	March 2017
Bromford will carry out further surveys of Paterson Road and Golden Farm Road which will include ecological surveys - looking for bats for example.	May 2017
You will be invited to an open evening to view and comment on the proposed housing layout.	June 2017
The comments received from residents about the proposed layout will be considered and revisions made to the plan where it is possible.	July 2017
Apply for planning permission.	August 2017
